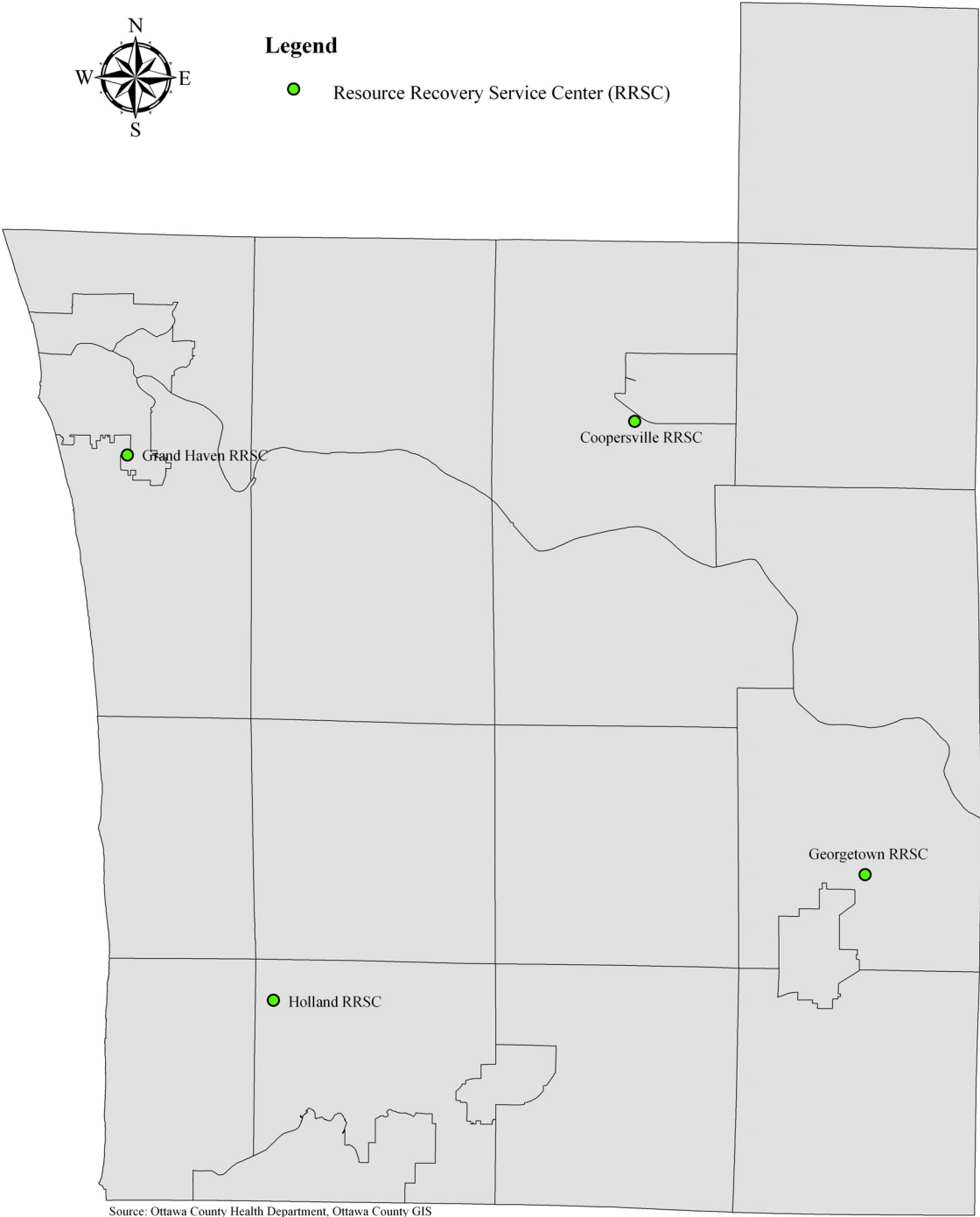


Recycling Sites* (Ottawa County, Michigan)

The majority of the waste collected is accepted at Ottawa County’s four Resource Recovery Service Centers (RRSC) or the permanent pesticide collection site at the Vriesland Growers Cooperative near Hudsonville

** **Hazardous Solid Waste:** pesticides, mercury, corrosives, and flammable solids

Hazardous Liquid Waste: used motor oil, solvents, anti-freeze, and other flammable liquids

Recyclables: newspaper, plastics, paperboard, cardboard, and other typical curbside materials
