WHY ? Michigan Law requires all dogs shall be licensed. The Ottawa County Board of Commissioners is conducting a comprehensive dog licensing program in Ottawa County.

DOG LICENSING IN OTTAWA COUNTY WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

WHO ? All Ottawa County residents who have a dog (s) that is four (4) months old or older must have a current Ottawa County dog license for their dog(s)

HOW ? To receive a dog license:

1. Fill out the application below.
2. Include a current rabies certificate & proof of spaying or neutering, if done, which will be returned to you.
3. Place check or money order in envelope and mail to:
