WHY ? Michigan Law requires all dogs shall be licensed.

WHO ? All Ottawa County residents who own a dog(s) that are four (4) months old or older must have a current Ottawa County dog license.

HOW ? To receive a dog license:

1. Fill out the application below.
2. Include a current rabies certificate & proof of spaying or neutering, if applicable, which will be returned to you.
