If a spouse, child, or other heir has been deceased for at least 28 days, there is a process that allows for distribution of property if the following applies:

- When there is no real property included in the estate
- The estate does not exceed \$15,000 (less liens/encumbrances)\*\*
- There has been no estate or petition for assignment of an estate filed with the Probate Court

**Step One:** If all the above apply, you can fill out the Affidavit of Decedent's Successor for Delivery of Certain Assets Owned by Decedent (PC 598).
