The Ottawa County Water Resources Commissioner will meet on the above date, time and location to receive construction bids for the Wildwood Springs No. 5 Drain. Bids will then be opened and publicly announced.

The Wildwood Springs No. 5 Drain will be let in one section(s) as follows, each section having the length, average depth and width as set forth:

Work shown on the drawings and specified herein generally described as: Construction of 2,934 lineal feet of open drain cleanout and construction, 165-feet of two stage channel, a cascade outfall and cobblestone channel, plain riprap, enclosed storm sewer ranging from 15-inch diameter to 36-inch diameter and associated appurtenances, plain rip rap, and also including HMA roadway and pathway restoration, concrete driveway restoration, and lawn restoration.

This Notice of Letting, the plans, specifications and bid proposal shall be considered a part of the Contract. The Contract will be let in accordance with the Contract Documents now on file at the Ottawa County Water Resources Commissioner's Office and available to interested parties. Copies of Bidding Documents may only be obtained upon payment of a \$30.00 non-refundable deposit. An additional non-refundable charge of \$10.00 will be required for sending out Bidding Documents. A security deposit in the form of a cashier's check, money order, certified check or bidders bond shall be submitted with any bids. No cash will be permitted. The security deposits of all unsuccessful bidders shall be returned after the Contract is awarded.

The Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder giving adequate security for the performance of the work and meeting all conditions represented in the Instructions to Bidders. The Contract completion date and the terms of payment will be announced at the time and place of letting. If no satisfactory bids are received, we reserve the right to reject any and all bids and to adjourn to a time and location as we shall announce.

The Ottawa County Water Resources Commissioner will hold a Day of Review of Apportionments and Drainage District Boundaries on the above date, time and location. **YOU ARE NOT REQUIRED TO ATTEND THE DAY OF REVIEW.**

The Day of Review is an opportunity to review the tentative apportionment of benefit for each parcel and municipality within the Drainage District and to review the boundaries of the Wildwood Springs No. 5 Drain Drainage District. The preliminary assessment roll and computation of costs are located at https://www.miottawa.org/Departments/Drain/wildwood_springs_no5.htm and a map of the proposed boundary revisions can be found attached to this notice and online at the above address as well.

The following entities will receive at-large assessments: Ottawa County and Spring Lake Township. The following is a description of the several tracts or parcels of lands constituting the Special Assessment District of the Wildwood Springs No. 5 Drain:

SPRING LAKE TOWNSHIP, TOWNSHIP 8 NORTH, RANGE 16 WEST
SECTIONS 4-5 and 8-9

The Water Resources Commissioner, engineers and/or other staff members will be available to assist individuals throughout the day and make revisions where necessary. There is no need to schedule an appointment for a specific time on the Day of Review. The computation of costs for the Drain will also be available at the Day of Review. Drain assessments are collected in the same manner as property taxes and will appear on your winter tax bill. If drain assessments are being collected for more than one (1) year, you may pay the assessment in full with any interest to date at any time and avoid further interest charges.

Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the Day of Review should contact the Water Resources Commissioner's Office at the number noted above (voice) or through the Michigan Relay Center at 7-1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the Day of Review to request mobility, visual, hearing or other assistance.

You may appeal the Water Resources Commissioner's decision to revise the district boundary to the Ottawa County Circuit Court within ten (10) days, and you may also appeal the determination of apportionments to the Ottawa County Probate Court within ten (10) days.
