Recently, an inspection was made of the Black Creek Intercounty Drain. The results of the inspection showed that there are areas of light to moderate deadfall and debris jams obstructing the flow of water in the drain. In order to allow the drain to flow unobstructed, the Black Creek Intercounty Drain Drainage Board has approved routine woody debris maintenance to be performed. A map of the proposed drain maintenance area is shown on the back of this letter.


A majority of this maintenance will be performed by the Allegan County drain maintenance hand-cleaning crew within the next few weeks, while the larger trees/obstructions will require a contractor to remove them. When a contractor has been chosen, a second notice will be sent to the applicable property owners.
