

Annual Unemployment Rates for Ottawa County, Michigan, and the United States (2000-2020)

The Ottawa County unemployment rate reached its highest monthly rate - 21.2% - since this data was first collected.¹ The unemployment rate has increased by over 7 percentage points since the most recent peak in July 2009.²
