- Clear and colored glass
- Plastics #'s 1-7 (no bags or film plastic)
- *Please clean all food containers and remove lids and labels*
- Consumer electronics at all sites.

WE DO NOT ACCEPT:

- Styrofoam/Expanded polystyrene
- Motor Oil Containers (for recycling)
- Tires
- Plastic Grocery Bag / Film Plastic
- Appliances
- Latex Paint
- Alkaline Batteries
- Compact Fluorescent Light Bulbs

*Annual membership is valid for one (1) twelve month period. A membership card will be issued and mailed to the address provided above. The membership card will provide participant access to the recycling center drop-off area. A membership renewal form will be mailed to the participant approximately one month prior to their card expiration.
