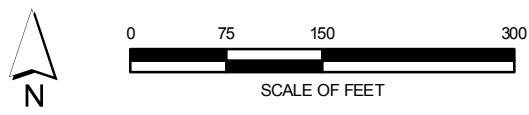
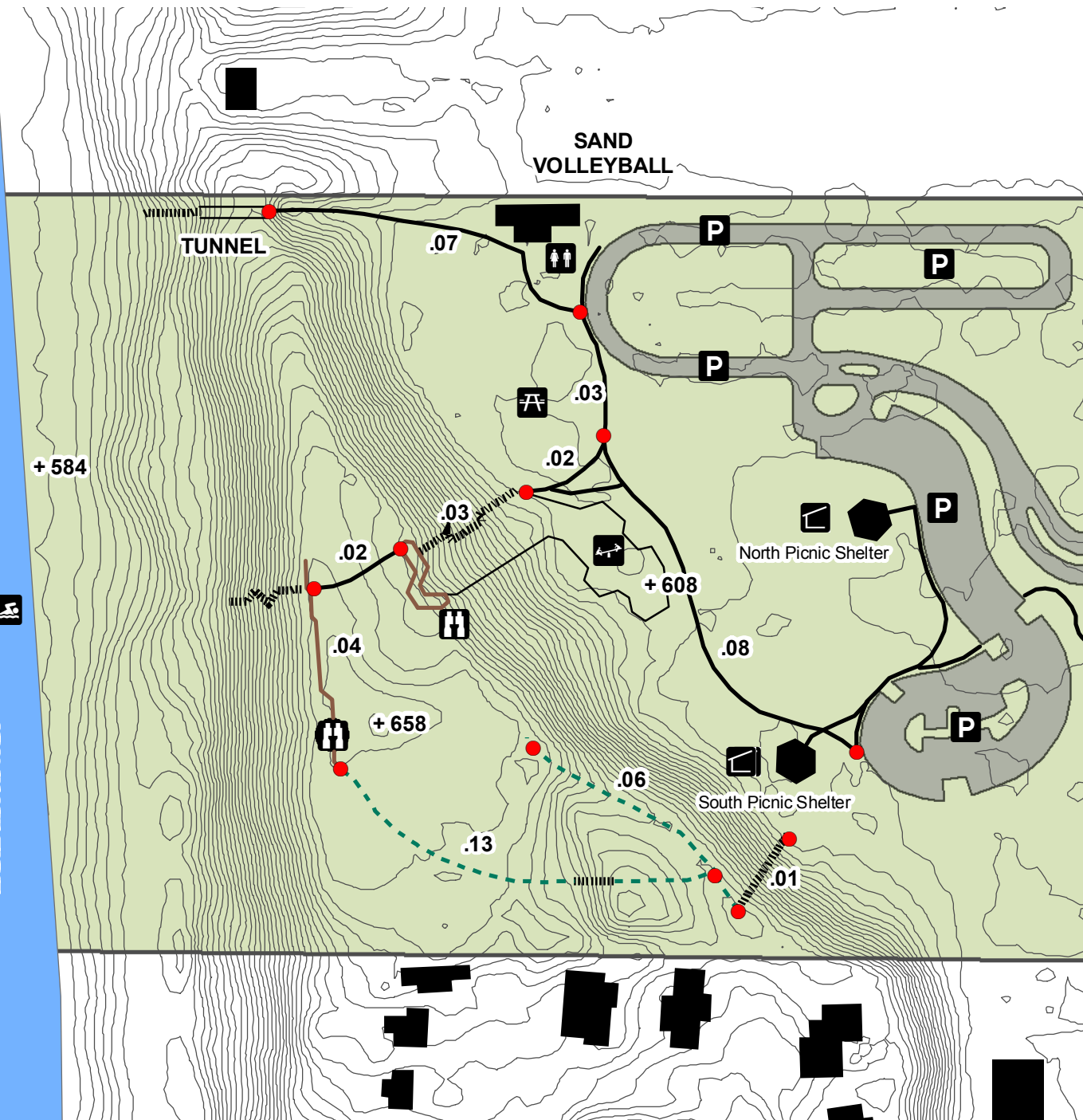
PARK USER INFORMATION

Along the shoreline of Lake Michigan, this popular 22 acre park is a great place for swimming, sunbathing and picnicking. In addition to the unique tunnel through a dune, this park has a children's playground complete with a dune climb and a dune stairway with scenic views of Lake Michigan. Note: Ottawa County provides NO LIFEGUARDS at parks with swimming facilities.

Facilities

- Two picnic shelters (reservable) - North Shelter & South Shelter
- Modern restrooms and changing rooms
- Children's playground with dune climb
- Dune stairway
- Picnic tables and grills
- Seasonal concession (vending machines only)
- Four sand volleyball courts
- Horseshoe pit

**barrier free facilities include both picnic shelters, restrooms, playground, some picnic tables and grills and trails to key use areas including through the tunnel to a beach overlook deck.*

Park Hours

April 1 through October 15 - 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.
October 16 through October 31 - 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
Tunnel Park is closed from November 1 through March 31

Fees

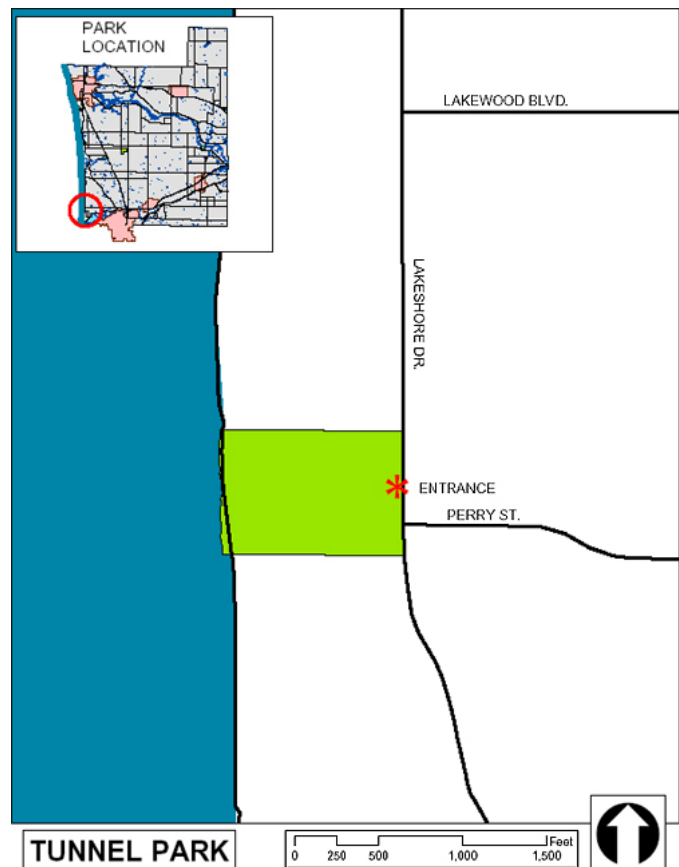
Motor vehicle parking fees are in effect from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend. Fees are as follows:

\$15.00 Annual
- Non-County Residents - \$7.00 Daily/
\$25.00 Annual
- Seniors (60 and older) - \$7.00 Annual
