Facility Reservations

- Reserve a facility at <https://www.miottawa.org/ParkReservations/> or by calling the Parks Office. Reservations may be taken up to one year in advance of the reservation date, beginning at midnight online. *The Nature Education Center may only be reserved by calling 616-786-4847.*
- Reservations must be paid in full at the time of booking.
- **Fishing Tournaments** may be scheduled at Riverside Park for \$120. Contact the Parks Office for more information. Participants must pay \$5.00 launch fee or have an annual park permit.
- **Amusements** (e.g. bouncy house, dunk tank, etc.) require an additional \$25 fee for up to three amusements, proof of liability insurance, and signed indemnification form (see sample, right). Must be approved in advance.

RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

THIS RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT made this ____ day of _____, 20____, between _____ of _____ hereinafter called "Indemnitor", and COUNTY OF OTTAWA, of 12220 Fillmore St., West Olive Michigan, hereinafter called "County."

WHEREAS, the County is the owner of a public park known as _____, hereinafter called "the Park"; and

WHEREAS, Indemnitor desires to use the Park for the purpose of a _____; and

WHEREAS, the County has no involvement with or control over the event to be conducted by Indemnitor; NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the respective covenants herein contained, IT IS HEREBY AGREED:

1. Indemnitor hereby fully and completely indemnifies County, its officers, agents, representatives and employees, from any and all liability, loss or damage County may suffer as a result of damage to property, claims, demands, costs, or judgments against it arising directly or indirectly from Indemnitor's use of the Park for the purpose of a _____, which event will take place on the ____ day of _____, 20____
2. Indemnitor agrees to defend against any claims brought or actions filed against County with respect to the subject of this Release and Indemnification Agreement contained herein whether such claims or actions are rightfully or wrongfully brought or filed.
3. The Indemnification under this Agreement shall commence upon execution of this Agreement and continue in full force until the termination of the above-mentioned event on the ____ day of _____, 20____
4. Indemnitor shall obtain and maintain for the duration of the event, an occurrence policy of liability insurance with limits as follows:
Property Damage \$ 250,000 Personal Injury \$ 500,000 per person \$1,000,000 per occurrence
 The insurance shall name the County of Ottawa as an additional insured, and indemnitor shall provide the County with adequate evidence of the insurance.
5. Indemnitor hereby agrees to release the county, its officers, agents, representatives and employees from any and all liability for personal injury, property damage or any other claims or causes of action directly or indirectly arising out of the event described herein.

Park Rules and Regulations

- A complete list of rules is posted on-site and online.
- **Animals** are not allowed in any rental areas or buildings. Assistance dogs are allowed if working and must be in uniform.
- All rental facilities are barrier-free unless otherwise specified.
- **Parking is not guaranteed with a reservation.** Parking is available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Alcohol Policy

Alcohol is prohibited on all park property, except by special permit at the Pine Bend Weaver House, Connor Bayou Woodland Cabin, Grand Ravines Lodge, and Nature Education Center at Hemlock Crossing. **Special permit fee of \$50 applies, along with a refundable \$250 alcohol security deposit.** With a special permit, beer and wine are allowed **only** in the rental area and not the entire park. *The presence of alcohol at an event without a special permit will result in forfeiture of your security deposit and possible event closure.*

Cancellations

Reservations that are cancelled 30 days or more in advance of the reservation date will receive a 50% refund of the reservation fee. Reservations cancelled less than 30 days in advance of the reservation date will result in the loss of the entire reservation fee.

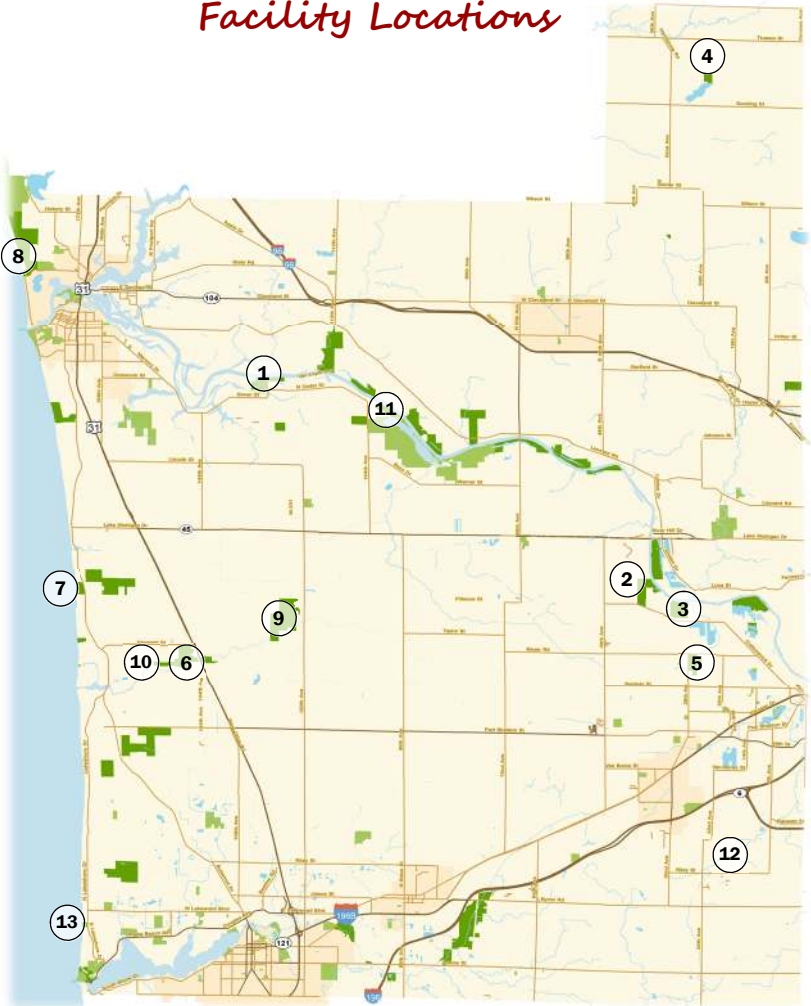

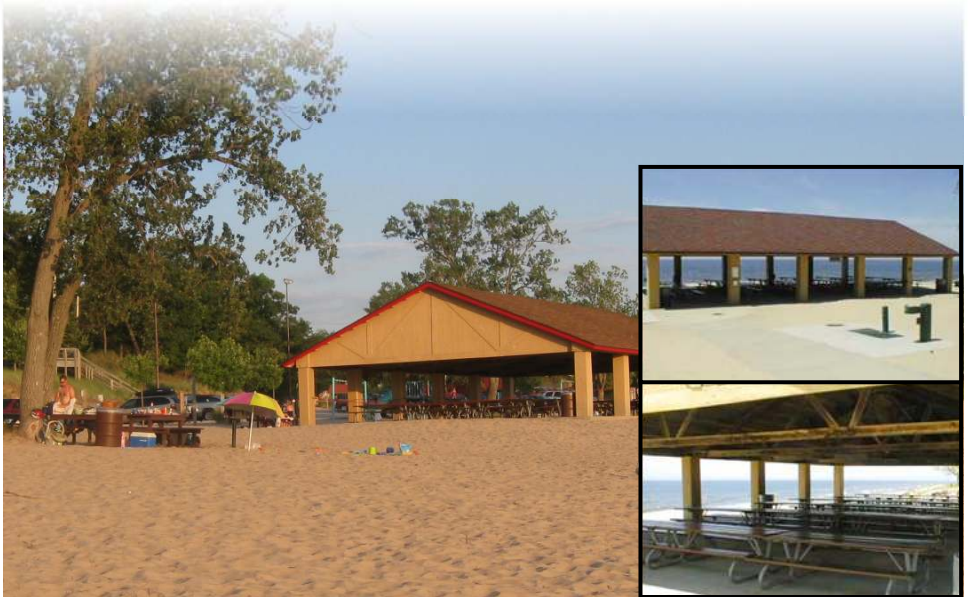

Outdoor Wedding Information

If you are considering an outdoor wedding in an Ottawa County Park, read the following information carefully. Call the Parks Office for additional information about the specific park you would like to use.

(These rules do not apply for rental areas at Grand Ravines Park, Spring Grove Park, Pine Bend Park, or Connor Bayou Park. Call the Parks Office for more information.)

- **If you choose to hold your ceremony at an Ottawa County Park, you MUST call the Parks Office at (616) 738-4810.**
- All outdoor areas are first-come, first-served.
 - » You may not rope off or “hold” space prior to your event.
 - » You may not block any walkways/boardwalks/stairs.
- All park rules and regulations are in effect.
- No amplified music or speaking. Music may be played during your ceremony, but it must not disturb other park guests.
- Pesticides, bug bombs, and similar products are not allowed.
- **ALCOHOL IS PROHIBITED on all park property, except by special permit at the Pine Bend Park Weaver House and Connor Bayou Woodland Cabin.**
- If you would like to provide seating for your guests or decorate the area, the following regulations apply:
 - » Chairs and/or decorations may only be put up 30 minutes before the ceremony and must be removed immediately after the ceremony is finished.
 - » Artificial flowers are not allowed.
 - » Birdseed, rice, confetti, and like products are not allowed.
 - » Candles or open flames are not allowed.
 - » Decorations that would cause damage to park property or buildings are not allowed.
- Parking is not guaranteed for any event. Parking areas may fill if it is a nice day or if large events are occurring.
