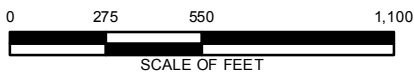
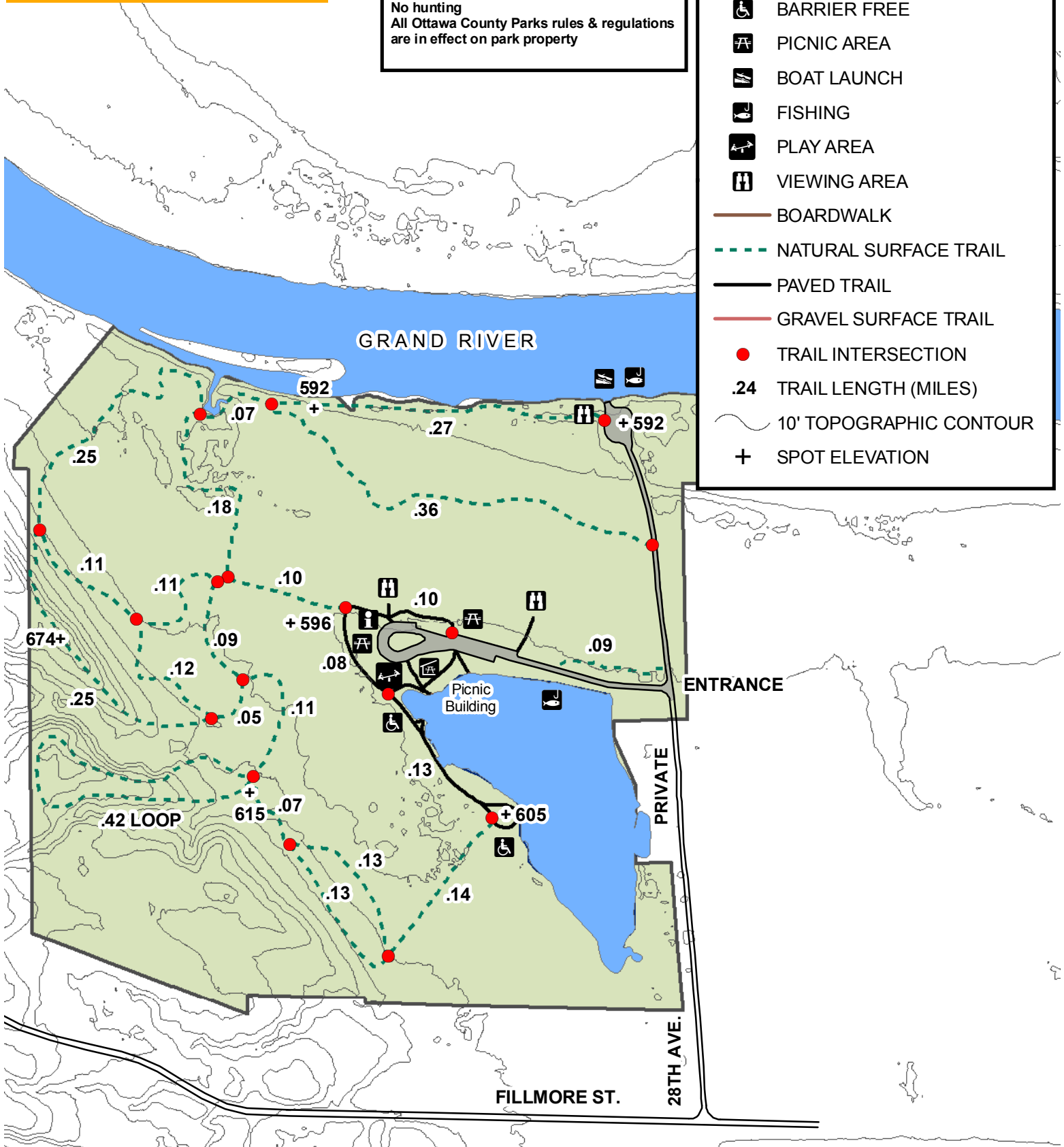

# Grand River Park

Upland woods, floodplain forest, restored native grasslands, wetlands and a small lake are some of the features of this 162 acre park along the banks of the Grand River. In addition to hiking, biking or skiing on the trails, visitors can also fish in the lake from a wooden boardwalk, enjoy the Grand River from an overlook platform or enjoy a picnic. The park also features a boat launch, a fully enclosed picnic building and a children's playground.

## Facilities

- picnic building (reservable)
- fishing dock on small lake
- boat launch
- children's playground
- wetland overlook platforms
- river overlook platform
- 3 miles of trails for hiking, mountain biking, and cross-country skiing.
- picnic tables and grills
- modern restrooms (closed in winter)

## Park Hours

Grand River Park is open year 'round

April 1 through October 31 - 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. November 1 through March 31 - 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

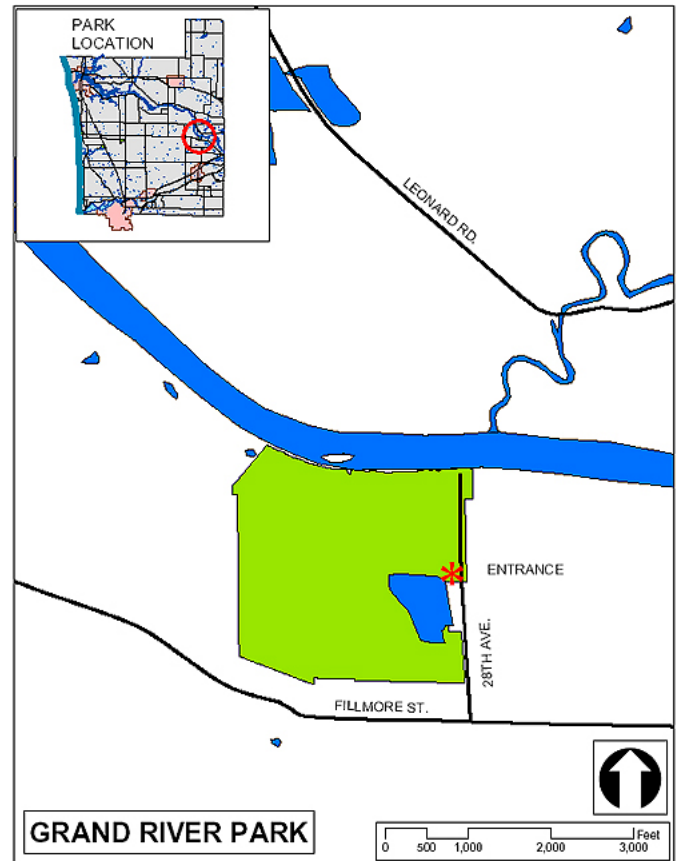
## Fees
