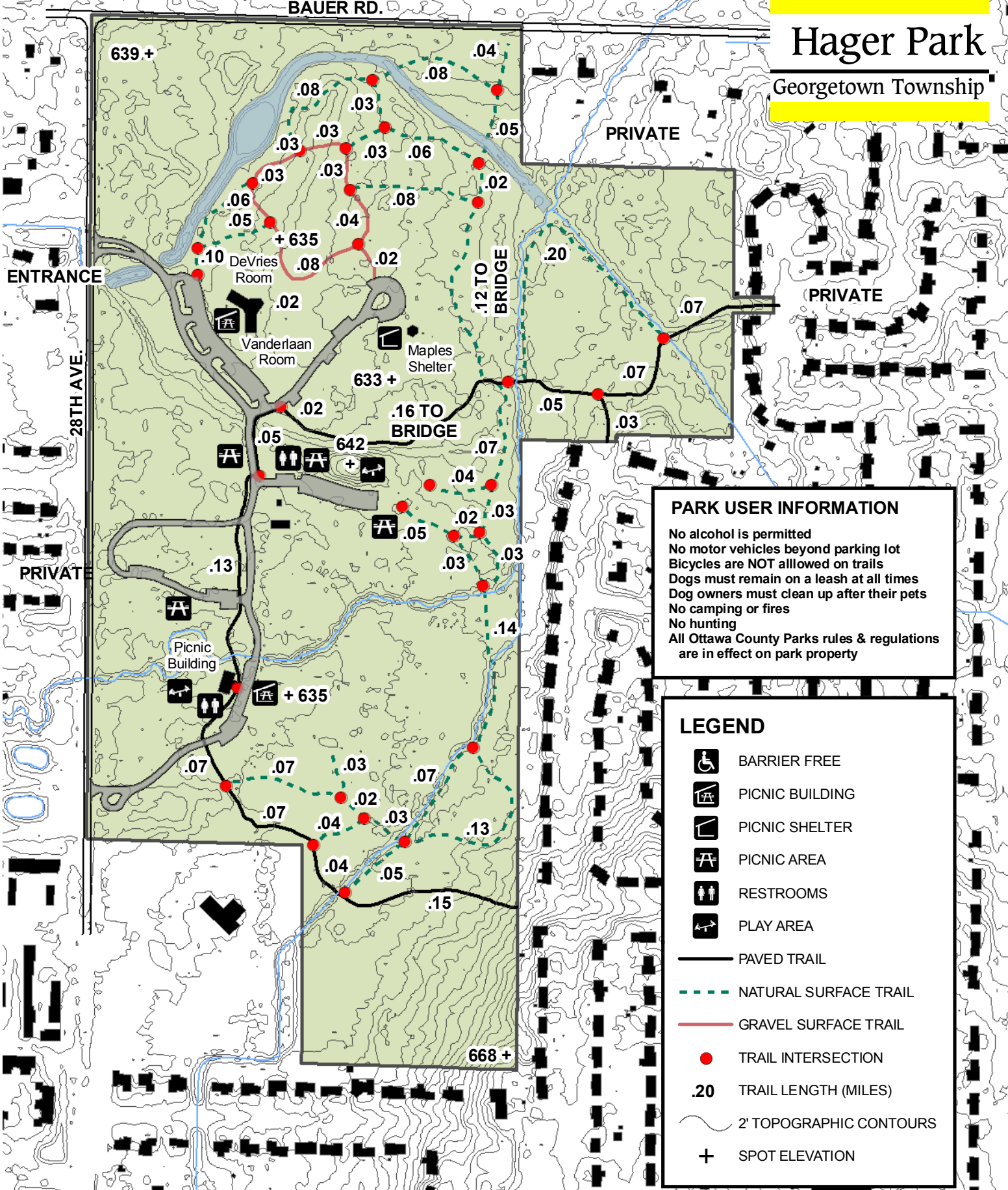


Hager Park

Georgetown Township

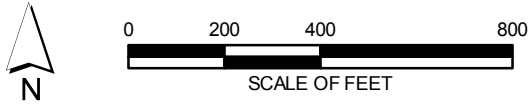


PARK USER INFORMATION

This popular 104 acre family park has a full array of recreational opportunities including extensive picnic areas and nature trails. The mature hardwood forest is well known for its spectacular spring wildflowers in April and May. A highlight of the park is the Age of Discovery community-built playground which overlooks a terrain map of the United States. Hager Creek has become highly eroded and is currently the focus of a major creek restoration project.

November 1 through March 31 - 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

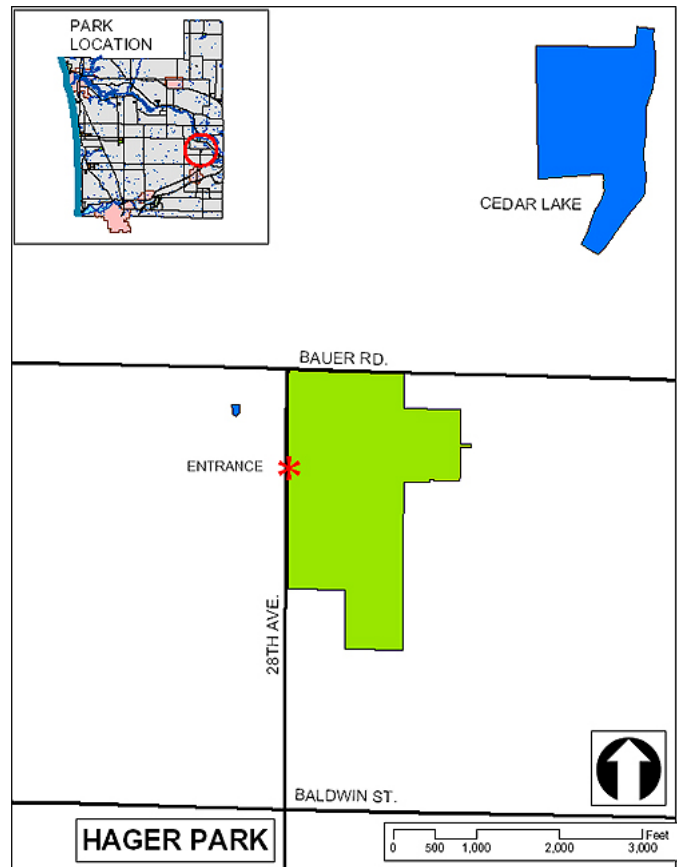
Fees
