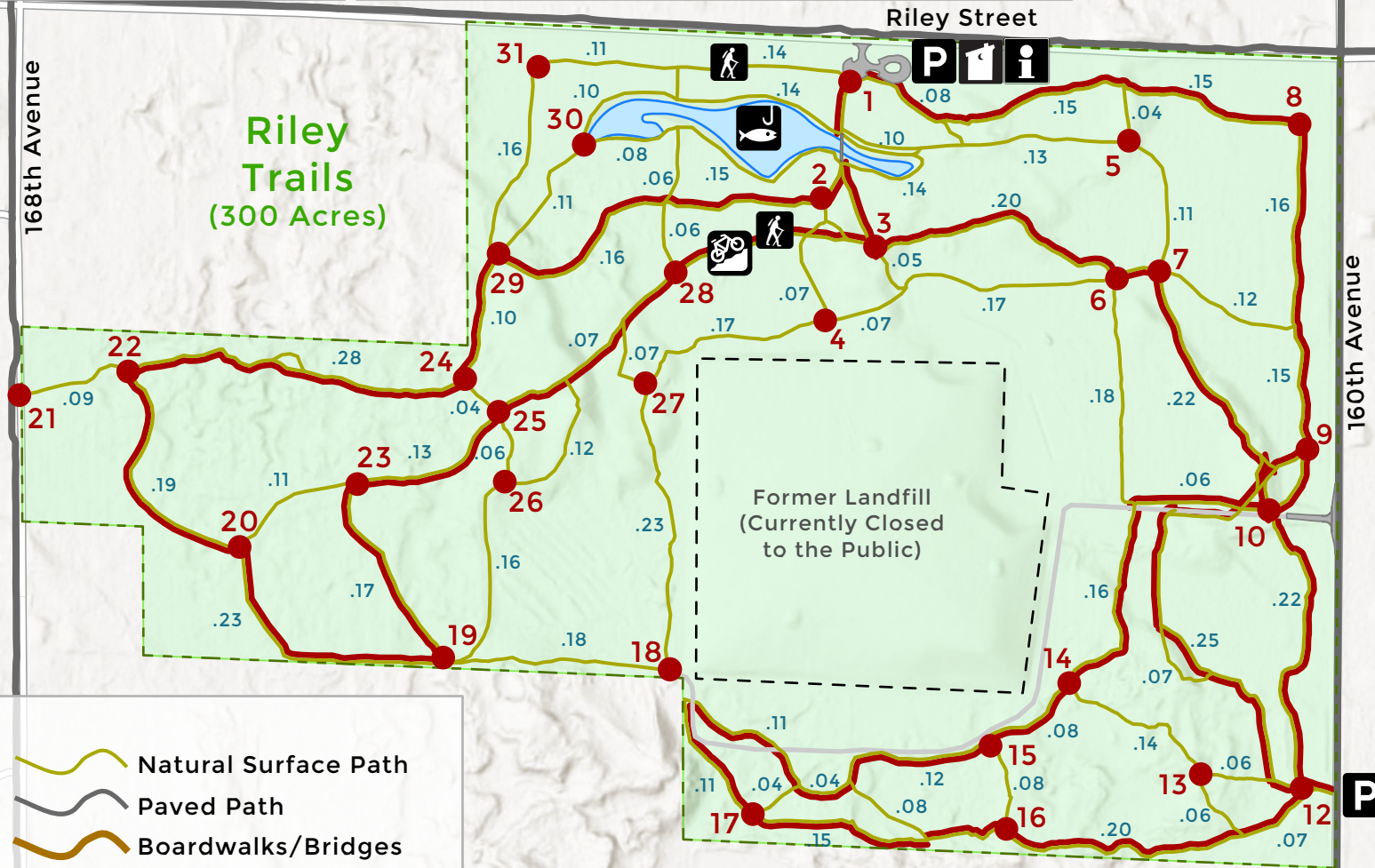
Park Township

Park User Information

- Park Hours:
March 1 to October 15 - 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
October 16 to February - 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- All trails are multiuse (bikers, hikers, dog walkers, skiers)
- No alcohol is permitted
- No motor vehicles beyond parking lot
- Dogs must remain on a leash at all times
- Dog owners must clean up after their pets
- No camping or fires
- No hunting
- All Ottawa County Park rules & regulations are in effect on park property

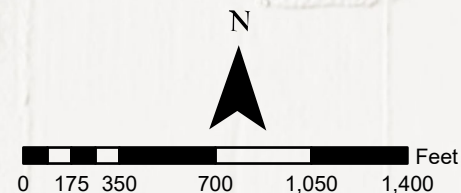
Etiquette for Multi-use Trails

- Be courteous and announce yourself if passing.
- Do not wear earbuds that will prevent you from hearing other users
- Know who has the right of way: Bicycles yield to hikers; hikers yield to skiers.
- Stay to the right on bidirectional trails.
- Walk opposite of the direction of the day on the mountain bike loop.
- Keep your dog leashed, close to you, and on the same side of the trail.
- Travel at a speed that is safe for all users and ride slower when not on the mountain bike loop.
- Class 2&3 ebikes with a throttle and motorized scooters, boards, or similar devices are not permitted on the trails.
