

Upper Macatawa Restorations (updated 01.17.11)

Work continues to restore and enhance native plant communities in the Upper Macatawa Natural Area. Over 15 acres of land were prepared and seeded in 2009 with a mix of native grasses and forbs to enhance both wet meadow and upland environments. An additional project to construct wetlands and convert former farm field to native grassland began in 2010 on 30 acres of land north of Byron Road and east of the Macatawa River. Final seeding will be completed in the spring of 2011.
