



INTELLECTUAL/ DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES IN CHILDREN & ADULTS CRITERIA

THE PERSON MUST HAVE A SEVERE, CHRONIC CONDITION THAT MEETS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

- Is attributed to a mental or physical impairment or a combination of both
- Started before age 22
- Is likely to continue indefinitely



AND:

THE SEVERE/CHRONIC CONDITION RESULTS IN SUBSTANTIAL FUNCTIONAL LIMITATIONS IN 3 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING MAJOR AREAS:

- Self Care
- Receptive and Expressive Language
- Learning
- Mobility
- Self-Direction
- Capacity for Independent Living
- Economic Self-Sufficiency

Eligibility is Determined by an interview, records, and the criteria above:
