COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH

THE PERSON MUST HAVE A SEVERE, CHRONIC CONDITION THAT...

- Is attributed to a mental or physical impairment or a combination of both
- Started before age 22
- Is likely to continue indefinitely



THE SEVERE/CHRONIC CONDITION RESULTS IN SUBSTANTIAL FUNCTIONAL LIMITATIONS IN 3 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING MAJOR AREAS:

Self Care

AND

- Receptive and Expressive Language
- Learning
- Mobility
- Self-Direction
- Capacity for Independent Living
- Economic Self-Sufficiency

Information is gathered through an interview and a record review.

To request mental health services, call the Access Center Monday through Friday between 8am and 5pm. If you would like to facilitate beginning services, you may call or walk in during business hours.
