Independent Supports Coordination



What does an Independent Supports Coordinator do?

A Supports Coordinator assists an individual to find and coordinate resources within the community to help meet their goals identified in their Individual Plan of Service.

A Supports Coordinator works to enhance quality of life by encouraging community integration, fostering independence, and encouraging self-determination.

An Independent Supports Coordinator provides these services but is not a Community Mental Health of Ottawa County employee. You have a right to choose a qualified Independent Support Coordinator through a contracted agency.*

Independent Supports Coordination is part of the personcentered planning process. It assures you that you have an ally in directing your person-centered planning process.
