The Drainage Board will also consider the December 15, 2020 petition for the maintenance and improvement of the intercounty drain to determine the sufficiency of said petition, to go over the route of intercounty drain, and to further determine where the maintenance and improvement of the intercounty drain is practicable, pursuant to Chapter 8 of Public Act 40 of 1956, as amended.
