
The Coopersville Community Trails Drain is located in the City of Coopersville, Ottawa County, Michigan.

The proposed maintenance and improvement is necessary for the public health, convenience or welfare and benefits the public health in the City of Coopersville.


The City of Coopersville will be liable for an assessment at large against it for a percentage of the cost of the proposed maintenance and improvement.
