Symptoms

- Fever (100.4°F and above)
- Chills
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Congestion or runny nose
- Headache
- Muscle or body aches
- Fatigue
- Cough
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell
- Diarrhea
- Nausea or vomiting

If you have experienced any of exposures or symptoms listed, please return home and contact your doctor.

This requirement is outlined in EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 2020-114 - Section 8 (g)

“Any business or operation that violates the rules in sections 1 through 14 has failed to provide a place of employment that is free from recognized hazards that are causing, or are likely to cause, death or serious physical harm to an employee, within the meaning of the Michigan Occupational Safety and Health Act, MCL 408.1011.”
