- 2. Long term needs assessment of agricultural industry.
- 3. Evaluating the adequacy of county storm drainage.
- 4. Drain code revision.
- 5. Support and coordinate transportation and public utility goals with the Road Commission.
- 6. Educate local governments on expansion of designated Natural Beauty Roads in Ottawa County
- 7. Study on County wide transportation.
- 8. Removal of non-judicial issues from the courts.
