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SUBJECT: DISCUSSION ITEMS

- 1. MERS Retiree Issue Rich Schurkamp explained a selected group of retirees is asking for a cost of living adjustment. This is the retirees of the Municipal Court who by statue were transferred to District Court. On June 1st, Rich wrote a letter to MERS regarding this group. He still doesn't have any answers from MERS. It was noted the Pension Fund has not been over funded since 1994-1995. These retirees had the chance to negotiate retirement when they were employed but choose an increase in wages instead. Requests for an increase happens yearly. The 457 Plan was also a choice the retirees could have opted into. Rich's ecommendation is to deny the request. The deny will be communicated to the retirees.
- 2. Budget Adjustment Limit Rosemary Zink recommends budget adjustment limits be increased from \$20,000 to \$50,000. This would be an increase within the fund only. Commissioners would still see copies. Consensus of the Committee was to go with this. Rosemary mentioned it would be put in as part of the budget resolution.
- 3. August 15th Meeting The August 15th Finance and Administration Committee Meeting has been canceled.
