Work Session Items:

- A. Term Limits of Appointments by the Board of Commissioners – Jane Ruiter reported the Personnel Committee has been looking into term limits of 12 years for the citizen appointees to Boards and Commissions and to allow rotation reappointment possible after two years. The Committee had considered a number of term lengths and decided on 12 years. Erika Rosebrook Dibble will assemble the terms on the present Boards and Commissions. The results will be available for the next Personnel Committee Meeting.
- B. K-16 Proposal – The Administrator reported Planning and Policy will be recommending this back to the full Board. He reported the Board making a decision doesn't violate Campaign Finance Law. The majority of the Board is opposed to the proposal.
