- General Fund Budget Update June Hagan, Fiscal Services Director, gave an overview of the General Fund budget where the County is at and where the County is going. She reported the departments have done a good job cutting back on their budgets and she can't see where they can cut back anymore. Administration is again recommending a hiring freeze. The budget is still \$1.3 million short. Administration is recommending using PA2 Funds – 50% to Health which is \$440,335 and \$895,852 from the General Fund Fund Balance to balance the budget. June feels this is a balanced approach to balance the budget this year. Will be brought back in two weeks.
