SUBJECT: DISCUSSION ITEMS

- 1. miOttawa.org Update
 - a. B/C 07-193 WebTecs, Inc. Two-Year Contract –JoAnn Arcand and Erika Rosebrook presented the "miOttawa.org" update. Total revenue growth has a 165% increase over 2006 YTD. On-line Park reservations are at 28% which is a very solid first year. JoAnn reviewed the 2006-2007 Application Development with the Committee.
- 2. ACS Contract Update David Hulst reported the ACS contract is due to expire in March 2008. This has been a five year contract. Gary Scholten is looking at what he wants to do. Erika Rosebrook reported Administration has been talking with Gary on how to migrate the information into "miOttawa.org".
- Information Technology Project Updates David Hulst presented the IT Update for September 2007. He gave a brief demonstration on the GIS Election Mapping. He reported IT will be doing the imaging workflow for Probate Court and District Court Probation.

4. Information Technology Policies Review – Dave reported the Administrator starting reviewing all county policies. Dave is looking at IT policies that are out-of-date. Policies need to protect the assets and users of the county and need to be educational, useful and flexible.
