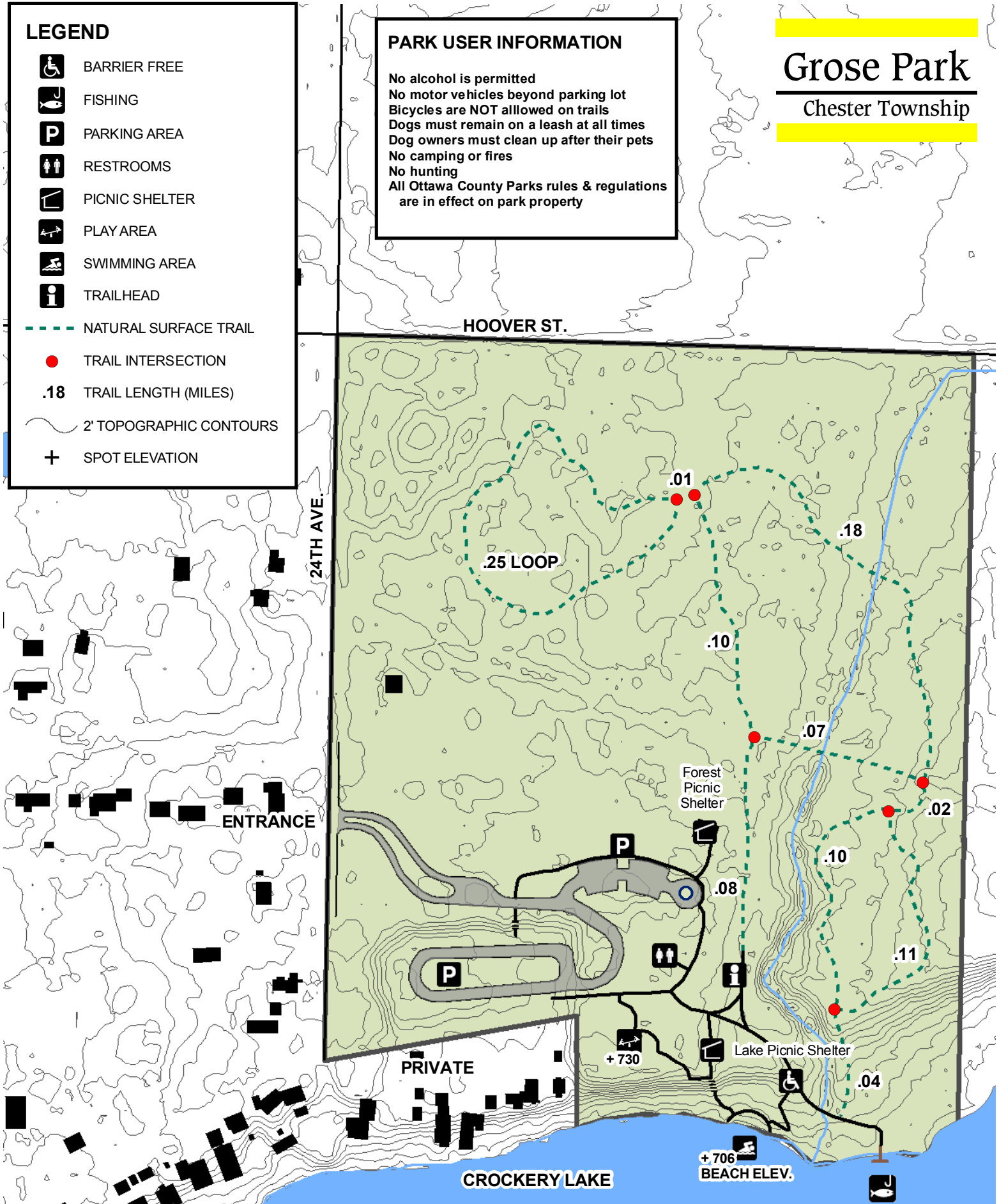

Overlooking Crockery Lake from a bluff amid towering trees, this 40 acre park provides a variety of recreational opportunities for the entire family including swimming, fishing, sand volleyball and picnicking. About one mile of hiking trails along a creek and through the woods offers abundant spring wildflowers from mid-April through May. Major improvements were made in 2000 to Grose Park as part of a \$660,000 renovation with about 60% of the funding coming from the Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund.

Note: Ottawa County provides NO LIFEGUARDS at parks with swimming facilities.

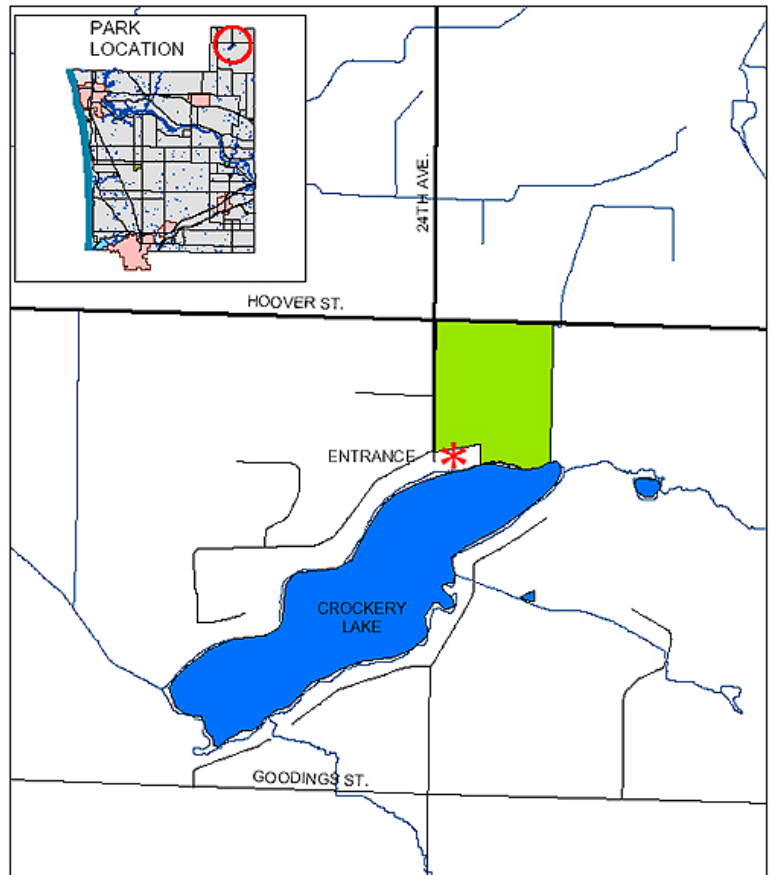
Fees
